1 ENTRY FEES | \$20 PER ARTWORK

Entry fees for all works in all categories to be submitted with Entry Form and payment to received by close of business (5pm) Friday 30 August, 2019. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Entry fees are Non Refundable.

2 ART ENTRIES

- a. Up to **two** pieces of work may be entered in each Section. All works must comply with Section descriptions.
- b. All entries must be the unaided work of entrant.
- c. All work must have been completed since **January 1 2018**.
- d. No works may have won a first prize at any exhibition
- e. No explicit material.
- f. Multi panel pieces accepted within size constraints.
- g. Artists may submit a statement on each artwork maximum 150 words.

All entries will be eligible for the overall first prize. The Emerging Artist Award is open to residents of either Bundaberg Council region, and Bundaberg or Burnett state electorates aged under 26 on 2 September 2019.

Sponsorship of \$500 or less by a family member or business will not preclude an artist from entering and winning a prize.

3 SALES

All works **must be for sale**, with price nominated on entry form.

A commission of 25% will be addded to all sales. The Bundaberg Arts Festival (ABN 90 281 981 382) is not registered for GST. Payment for sales will be paid to entrant at the end of the Festival.

4 IDENTIFICATION

All artworks must be clearly **marked on the base of rear** with the competitor's name, address, phone number, title of work, medium, section and selling price. Tags can be downloaded from the website

5 CONDITION OF WORK

All paintings, prints, photographs and other hanging works must be dry, suitably and safely framed, fitted with D-hooks and strung ready for hanging. Paintings on stretcher frames will be accepted, unless otherwise specified, on the condition that the staples are at the back.

Reasonable care will be taken in handling artwork however the BAFA will not be responsilbe for any loss or damage whatsoever caused to any work while in it's custody.

6 PUBLICITY

Artists will allow their work to the photographed without fee during the exhibition and the Bundaberg Arts Festival Association Inc reserves the right to reproduce entries for publicity (not limited to, print media, television, online, social media, catalogues) in association with the awards, now and in the future.

7. INSURANCE

Entrants are responsible for their own insurance. The Bundaberg Arts Festival Association Inc accepts no responsibility for damage or loss, either during installation, while on display or while in tranist.

8 DECISIONS

The judge's decision is final. The Association will not enter into discussion or correspondence regarding a decision. The Bundaberg Arts Festival Association Inc reserves the right to reject any work submitted, with reasons to be submitted in writing on request.

All artworks will be viewed by the judge, but due to space limitations, not all artworks may be displayed.

DELIVERY

Delivery of Artworks will be between the hours of **9am and 3pm on Sunday 15 September 2019**, to a location in the Bundaberg CBD.

Location will be advised via email closer to the event.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Works are to be addressed to Bundaberg Arts Festival and be delivered to ART PLUS, 15 Electra Street, Bundaberg, Qld, 4670.

RETURN FREIGHT: Entrants are responsible for return of their own work. All freight costs shall be prepaid. Consignment notes shall accompany the packages. Works sent by Australia Post shall be returned C.O.D. COLLECTION

IN PERSON: Artworks are to be collected from the Bundaberg CBD location* between the hours of 9.30 am and 3.00 pm Sunday, 29th September 2019

If a person other than yourself is collecting your work record their name and contact details on entry form.


Any other person collecting your work must have signed permission with them on the day of collection.
